

Using JPEGView Slide Shows (for Macintosh Users)

JPEG View is a shareware program that can be downloaded from the Internet. After you have downloaded the program, send the author a postcard to say "Thank you!" You can download JPEGView at http://shareware.netscape.com/computing/shareware/software_title.tpl?p=MAC&category_id=60&subcategory_id=68&id=55331 Or just go to <http://shareware.netscape.com> and search for JPEG view.

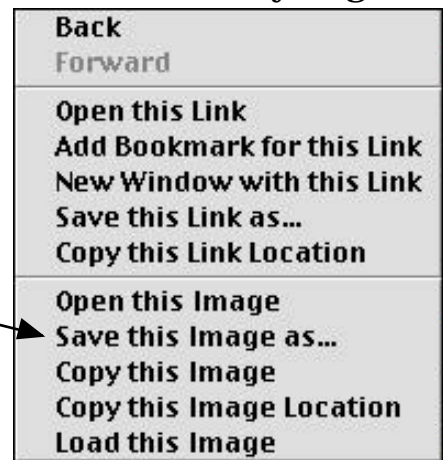
You need a copy of JPEGView. The folder looks like this:



1. Decide what topic you want for your slide show. Create a folder on your hard drive and title it with whatever topic you choose, like "Missions" or "Plants". (To create a folder, either choose "New" from the File menu, or type N on your keyboard.)

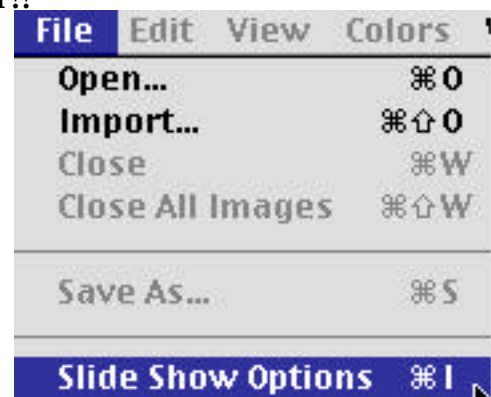
2. Find pictures on the Internet or scan in pictures related to your topic. To find pictures, you can use a search engine such as Lycos (<http://www.lycos.com>), and click on "advanced search". Then, type in your keyword and select "pictures" as what you want to search for. Remember to note where you got the pictures!

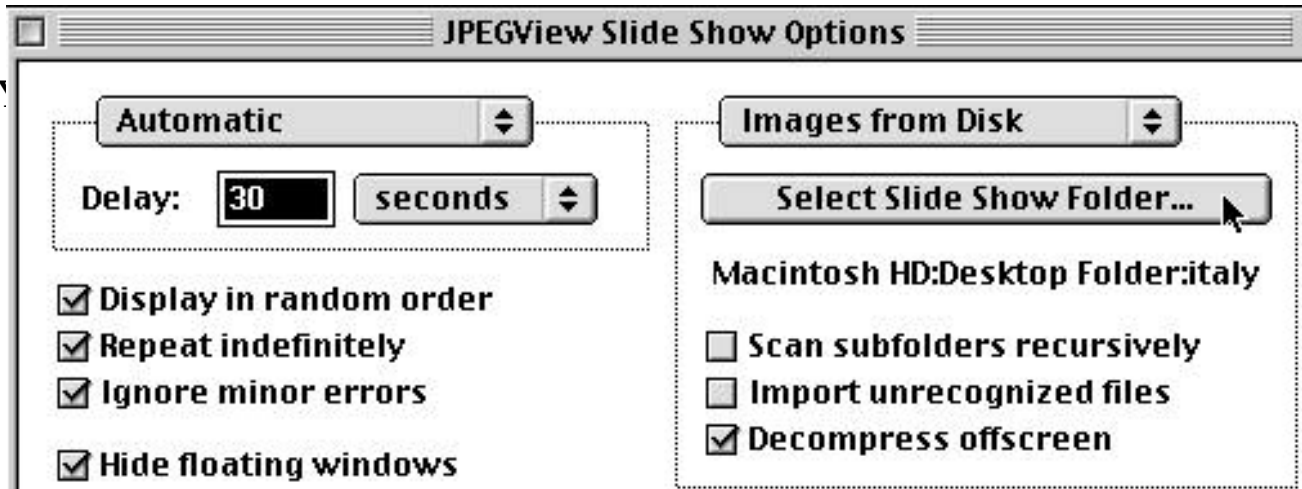
3. Once you find pictures that you want to use, save them to your folder. Click on the picture and hold the button down until a menu pops up. Select "Save this Image as ...", navigate to your folder and press the save button.



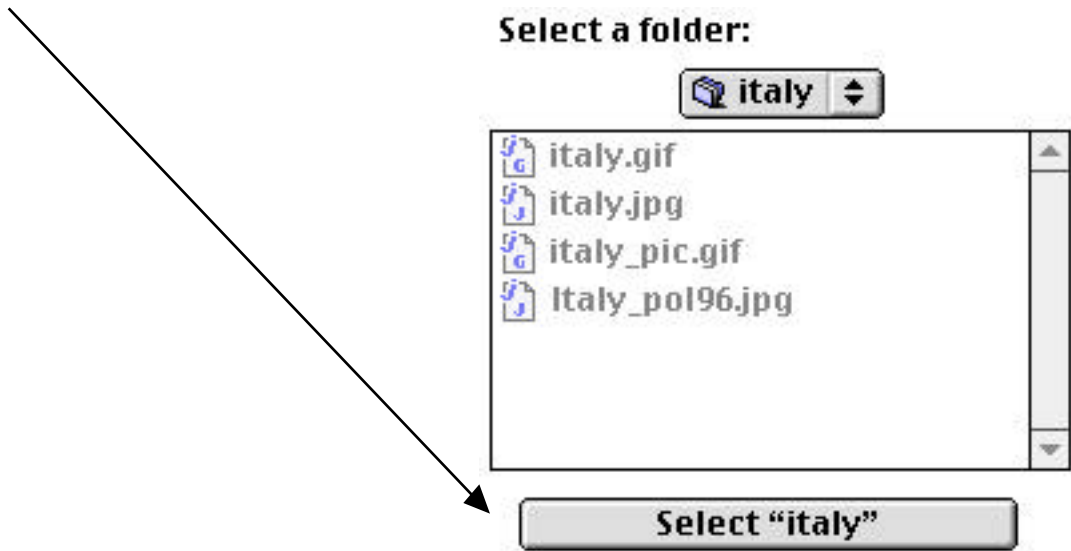
If you want your slide show to show in a particular order, name your pictures "01 ...", "02 ...", "03 ...", etc. This will keep them in order!

4. Now you are ready to start your slide show. Open the JPEGView folder and double-click on the JPEGView icon. Go to the "File" menu and select "Slide Show Options".





Click on “Select Slide Show Folder ...”, and find your folder. Click “Open” on the dialogue box, and then click “Select ...” (... is whatever the name of your folder is).



5. Then click on “Begin” in the slide show dialogue box and watch your slide show! When you finish watching the show, click the stop button (the one with the rectangle), move the cursor to the top of the screen and click. The menu bar will appear, and go to “Close” under the File menu.



You can change the speed of the slides in the slide show dialogue box, as well as if you want to view the slides at random or not.
